101 **CONCERNING COUNTY SPENDING AUTHORITY FOR ENVIRONMENTAL**
102 **SUSTAINABILITY MEASURES.**

Bill Summary

Authorizes the board of commissioners of a county to provide in the county budget for programs to improve environmental sustainability within the county.

1 **SECTION 1.** 30-11-107 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
2 amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW PARAGRAPH to read:

3 **30-11-107. Powers of the board.** (1) The board of county
4 commissioners of each county has power at any meeting:

5 (ii) TO PROVIDE IN THE COUNTY BUDGET FOR PROGRAMS THAT
6 SUPPORT EDUCATION AND OUTREACH ON ENVIRONMENTAL
7 SUSTAINABILITY WITHIN THE COUNTY BUT DO NOT EXEMPT THE COUNTY
8 FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF ANY OTHER STATUTE.

9 **SECTION 2. Effective date.** This act shall take effect at 12:01
10 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after
11 final adjournment of the general assembly that is allowed for submitting
12 a referendum petition pursuant to article V, section 1 (3) of the state
13 constitution, (August 8, 2007, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2007);
14 except that, if a referendum petition is filed against this act or an item,
15 section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section,
16 or part, if approved by the people, shall take effect on the date of the
17 official declaration of the vote thereon by proclamation of the governor.
